Daniel, Ann Sofie, Tiziana, and Kim will lead a 5 day workshop with dance students from Ohio State University, USA; Danish National School of Performing Arts' and dancers and musicians of the participating NORDPLUS Explorations and Collaborations in the Arts / The ECA network. The workshops will allow dancers to participate in technique classes (6-8 hours) with Roberts (Cunningham Technique) and Clemmensen (floor-work), as well as accomplished dance teachers from Copenhagen. This will be an opportunity for mentorship of students in the MAD (Musical Accompanist for Dance) program at DDSKS, as well as musicians for the NORDPLUS ECA network.

Roberts and Kim Helweg propose a 5 day workshop (12-16 hours) for Music and Choreography, where musicians and choreographers examine music composition techniques (Baroque music, Minimalism/Repetition, Jazz) to develop choreographies with new music scores.
